


How to view an email encrypted by Microsoft

A message that is encrypted by Office 365 Message Encryption is delivered to a recipient's inbox just like any other email message, but it contains an HTML file attachment named message.html.

Click on the attachment in the message named message.html. You may be prompted to *Download* or *Save* the file first and then *Open* it.



After opening the message.html attachment, the recipient can choose the following options to view the message:

Option 1:

Sign in and view message with a Microsoft Account which requires registration if you do not already have a Microsoft account. (See Option 1 instructions below)

Option 2:

Request a one-time code to view the message (See Option 2 instructions below)

Option1:

Sign into Microsoft and view the message.

Click "Sign in and view your encrypted message".

TO SIGN UP FOR A NEW MICROSOFT ACCOUNT

This is a one-time set up if you do not already have a Microsoft account.

You will be directed to a page to create an account and select a user name and password as well as complete other information.

****This account can be used to view other encrypted messages through Microsoft in the future****

Create an account

You can use any email address as the user name for your new Microsoft account, including addresses from Outlook.com, Yahoo! or Gmail. If you already sign in to a Windows PC, tablet, or phone, Xbox Live, Outlook.com, or OneDrive, use that account to [sign in](#).



IMPORTANT: If you already sign in to a Windows PC, tablet, or phone, Xbox Live, Outlook.com, or OneDrive, use that account to [sign in](#) to view the message.

Tip: By clicking the **Keep me signed in** checkbox, Microsoft will remember your credentials on your computer and open the message without having you sign in again.

<p>Option 2: Click “Get a one-time passcode to view the message”</p>	<p>Don't want to sign in? Get a one-time passcode to view the message.</p>
<p>A one-time code for that encrypted email will be sent to the recipients email address.</p> <p>Once you get the email with the code...</p>  <p>...enter the code from the email into the passcode field on the screen.</p> <p>Click CONTINUE to read the message</p> <p>Click this link if you need another passcode sent to you.</p>	<p>We sent a passcode to ██████████@yahoo.com.</p> <p>Please check your email, enter the passcode that corresponds with the reference code, and click continue. The passcode will expire in 15 minutes.</p> <p>Reference code: 9623</p> <p>Passcode <input type="text"/></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> This is a private computer. Keep me signed in for 12 hours.</p> <p> CONTINUE</p> <p>Didn't receive the passcode? Click here to get another one.</p>
<p>You will now be able to view the encrypted message.</p>	<p><i>Please note that if you have used this option, close out of the message and then need to reread the message again you will need to request another code.</i></p>
